	It was understood that WDDC had made an objection regarding the withdrawal of
	the telephone facility in the High Street. The County Council had agreed that the
	PCC could erect a finger post pointing to the Church car park. The clerk had written to Mr Cunningham regarding the footpath query.

	There are still a number of drainage problems, one of which is in Holditch. Water is
	still running along the road beside Saddle Street and another problem is at Higher
	Synderford. The footbridge at Buddlewall is sagging on the Dorset side. There are
	problems in Chard Street with parking. On occasions the large amount of parking is
	preventing buses and heavy vehicles getting through. This has caused a delay of at
	least 15 minutes on a number of occasions.
