

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VENN HILL, THORNCOMBE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along VENN HILL, THORNCOMBE from its junction with Saddle Street to its junction with Causeway Lane, a distance of approximately 1200 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 18 September 2019 between 0800 and 1800 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 September 2019.

**This Notice will enable BT safe access to install new ducting into existing ducting in the highway.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Chard Street - Wheel House Lane - B3162
