

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY W44/47, THORNCOMBE

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. All pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along Bridleway W44/47 from grid reference **ST 352 022** (point A on the map below) to grid reference **ST 350 020** (point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 305 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It came into operation on 20 August 2024 and can remain in force for a period of 21 days.

This Notice is required for health and safety reasons due to water damage to the surface.

On this occasion there is no suitable alternative route.
